- Yearly certification exam
- No background education requirements



### ACRE

Association of Community Rehabilitation Educators

### Requirements:

- 40-60 hours of coursework
- Earn a certificate
- No background education requirements

# A CLOSER LOOK AT ACRE

ACRE training is designed to instill knowledge across 39 competencies (across 4 domains) necessary for improving the quality of services provided to people with disabilities.
